NOTICE OF TOWN ROAD RECLASSIFICATION

Notice is hereby given that by ORDER of the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Brookline, Vermont dated September, 1989, said ORDER having been duly made after notice, inspection and hearing pursuant to 19 VISA § 292 and §341, the following public highway of the Town of Brookline, Vermont has been reclassified to a Town Trail.

Being Windmill Hill Road (Town Highway #13), so-called, and commencing at the easterly side of Grassy Brook Road at property of Henry and Roma Donais, thence in a southeasterly direction across lands of said Donais then along lands of Dennis and Reissa Shield and Orlando and Margaret Brewer; thence in a northeasterly direction along lands of Orlando and Margaret Brewer and Leonard and Elizabeth Parsons; thence in a southeasterly and easterly direction through lands of said Brewer to the town line of the Town of Westminster, being approximately 1.00 miles in length.

The September 6, 1989 Selectmen's Meeting was held with Maynard Bush and Nelson Fontaine present. Also present was Joyce Rogers.

The minutes of the August 16, 1989 Selectmen's Meeting were read and approved.

Nothing further has been done with grader shed.

Maynard spoke with Szappanos regarding property for the Town. Szappanos is contacting his lawyer to begin the transfer process.

Nelson reported that all roadside mowing is done.

Nelson reported that retreatment is done and felt that Lane did a good job.

The school has taken the topsoil from out back of the Town Office.

Nelson checked the Greer Bridge and said that the planking needs to be done soon and Nelson will take care of this.

Nelson said that Wilcox apologized for the mess he made of Athens Road while he was working. Gravel has been put in hole and Nelson said that it will be finished when doing fall grading.

Paperwork from Hans was received and reviewed regarding Windmill Hill Road. It was adopted that Windmill Hill Road has been reclassified as a trail - this order and notice duly signed September 6, 1989 by Maynard Bush and Nelson Fontaine. Joyce will take care of legal notice, certified mailings and posting.

Nelson brought up building up shoulders - Maynard also thought this is something that should be done. This will be discussed further at the next meeting.

Notes were gone over from Chris - regarding a call Chris received from Paul AuCoin who requested that a friend hook up his trailer while AuCoin is away for three months. Both Bill Staats and Chris felt there was no problem with this, but advised AuCoin they did not know the State's position in this matter and if someone complained, AuCoin would have to take care of the matter.

Regarding road signs - Joyce said the posts may be at the Town Yard.

Chris called Bill Noyes that retreatment has been completed and we are ready for relining. Chris also asked about request for grant for bridges and culverts - Bill responded we were not given the grant this year as other towns had more pressing needs, however, this will be a request that may be resubmitted each year.

It was agreed that the igloos be temporarily placed at Town Yard and be moved to larger site when land received from Szappanos.

Chris reported that he had received calls where water has washed out under pavement on Hill Road - Nelson is aware of the location and will take care of filling in this area.

A check for reimbursement of work done on Bennett Road was received from Swing.

There being no further business, after doing the payorders, the meeting adjourned at 8:39 p.m.
