

WHEREAS, by resolution dated June 5th, 1984, the selectmen of the Town of Dover proposed a discontinuance of Pisgah Road, lying in the Town of Dover, Vermont; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said resolution, a hearing was duly noticed and held on the twenty-sixth day of June, 1984 to consider the proposal to discontinue said highway; and

Whereas, the Selectmen of the Town of Dover conclude by vote that it is in the best interest of the Town to discontinue said highway; and

WHEREAS, the discontinued highway has been described as set forth below; and

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners have waived any and all claim to damages as a result of this action;

NOW THEREFORE, it is ordered:

That the following described road is hereby and shall be discontinued as a highway, said land to vest in the owners of adjoining lands pursuant to statute:

T.H. #40 known as Pisgah Road being 0.32 miles which begins at Handle Road (T.H. #6) and ends at the Mount Snow Parking Lot. And as is further described in the Dover Land Records, Book 18, page 528 and Book 33, pages 261 - 264.
