Title 19. V. S. A. Section 305

SEC. 305. MEASUREMENT OF HIGHWAYS

(Q) A representative of the agency in the presence of the selectmen or their designee shall measure and inspect the class 1,2 and 3 town highways in each town at least once every ten years. The agency shall notify the town when any highway, or portion of a highway, does not meet the standards for its assigned class if the town falls, within one year, to restore the highway or portion of the highway to the accepted standard, or to reclassify, or to discontinue, or develop an acceptable schedule for restoring to the accepted standards, the agency for purposes of apportionment under section 306 of this title shall deduct the affected mileage from that assigned to the town for the particular class of the road in question.

(b) Annually, on or before February 10, the selectmen shall, after review by a representative of the agency, file with the town clerk a sworn statement of the description and measurements of all class 1, 2 and 3 town highways, then in existence, including any special designation such as a throughway or scenic highway. When class 1, 2 or 3 town highways are accepted, discontinued, or reclassified, a copy of the proceedings shall be filled in the town clerk's office and a copy shall be forwarded to the agency.

(c) The agency shall not accept any change in mileage until the records required to be filed in the town clerk's office by this section are received by the agency.

(d) The selectmen of any town who are aggrieved by a finding of the agency concerning the measurement, description or classification of a town highway may appeal to the board by filing a notice of appeal with the executive secretary of the board.

Title 19. V. S. A. Section 2502 Added 1985

Sec. 2502. TOWN SCENIC ROADS, DESIGNATION AND DISCONTINUANCE

(a) On recommendation of the planning commission of a municipality, or an the initiative of the legislative body of a municipality, a legislative body may, after one public hearing warned for the purpose, designate or discontinue any town highway or portion of a town highway as a town scenic highway. Such action by the legislative body may be petitioned by the registered voters of the municipality pursuant to the provisions of section 1973 of Title 24.

(b) A town scenic road may be reconstructed or improved in a manner consistent with the standards established by the transportation board, pursuant to section 425 of Title iO. A class I, 2 or 3 scenic highway shall still be eligible to receive aid pursuant to the provisions of this title.

(c) The legislative body of a municipality may appeal for a variance from standards promulgated by the transportation board. In these appeals the board's decision shall be final.

Dear Mr. Chabot:

Enclosed please find the documentation to support the designation of Town Highway #34 from a legal trail to a Class 3 Town Highway which is recorded in Book 35, Pages 401-403 of the Halifax Land Records. Since Town Highway #34 is measured at 1.16 miles and two sections of the road had previously been classified as Class 3, there remains .71 miles to reclassify as Class 3.

In looking at the most recent highway map prepared by the Vermont Agency of Transportation, there are several errors. The Windham County Superior Court on June 11, 1987 filed for recording a Judgment Order which amends some of the roads which the Board of Selectmen had previously designated on July 24, 1972 as legal trails. According to the Judgment Order the following roads which had been designated by the Selectmen as trails were amended by the Court to remain as public highways:

Town Highway # 52	mileage not measured
Town Highway # 50	mileage not measured
Town Highway # 58	mileage not measured
Town Highway # 35	0.24 miles (which has been reclassified

Town Highway # 34	0.29 miles (which has been reclassified




