Jamaica Selectboard Meeting
January 24, 2000
Upstairs in Town Office Building.

Meeting called to order by Bruce Chapin at 7:30 P.M.

Selectboard Present: Bob O'Brien, Arnold Young, David Hamilton, Bruce Chapin, Clara Robinson.

Public Present: Bonnie West, Cate Kelly, Elaine Beckwith, Glenn Gibson, Greg Joly, Beth Meachem, Bill Uptegrove, Morty Fink, Ralph Coleman, Mora Gerhing, Charlie Peck.

1. Motion made by Clara Robinson to approve the minutes of January 10, 2000, regular meeting with correction, and January 12, 2000 Public Hearing, with correction of letters deleted from the Planning Commissions packet on Pikes Falls Land Issue, requested by Elaine Beckwith; this motion seconded by Bob O'Brien, and so moved.

2. Orders #66-70 approved and signed.

3. Highway time sheets: 1 for 1/15/2000 reviewed.

4. Sheriff's report for 11/28-12/11/1999 reviewed.

5. Vote on Pikes Falls Issue: Motion made by Clara Robinson, based on the input from the Public Hearing; research done by the town lawyer; the Planning Commission; that the Town of Jamaica accept the Pikes Falls Property on behalf of the Town; with the stipulation that if the property becomes a burden to the Town, the Selectboard will re-open negotiations with the Vermont Land Trust; this motion was seconded by Bob O'Brien; Clara, Bob, Bruce in favor, David, Arnold against; this motion so passed. Charlie Peck made the comment that he wanted the Town to take down the rope, and any other believed hazardous structures, before the Town takes over.

6. Certificate of milage signed; Arnold made the motion that 1300&30ft. (1/4mile) be added to West Hill North in the Town of Jamaica, and to reclassify from class four to class three; this motion seconded by David, all in favor, so moved.

Letter on speed limit in Rawsonville; acknowledged.

7. Finalize 2000-2001 Budget and Selectboard Report:

A. Road Crew: 60% raise for Healthcare; raise to start in July.

B. If the Board doesn't get a Budget request asking for money, the Board will not put request in Budget.

Motion made by David Hamilton to finalize the Budget, seconded by Bob O'Brien, all in favor, so moved.

8. The Board looked over the draft copy of Warning; Warning looks okay; Bonnie West mentioned to the Board that the Warning couldn't be finalized until after January 27th., as maybe other articles may come in before Warning.

9. Thank you letter, letter on Pikes Falls Issue, letter from Mr. Uptegrove asking not to be reappointed to Planning Commission; acknowledged.

10. Non-Agenda:

Bruce: February 4th. 2000, next meeting on Traffic.

Arnold: Global Recycling got burned out; Mr. Sargent asked the Board to be patient, he is still in business, will try to do better.

Clara: Clothes box working out okay; Paper at Transfer station going better.

Clara had people approach her about volunteer restoration on Town Hall; Chris Clark- Wiring lights outside. Maybe some more will be interested on this.

Bob: Break-Ins at Town Garage; Sheriff's have a suspect; working on this. Bob suggested both Raymond and Irene (Tootie) Smith have the Town Report dedecated to them, instead of just Raymond. All were in favor.

David: Met with Mathew Beck-plans on Turkey Mt. road; also talked with Bruce and Ulman; waiting to meet with them to go over plans.

Another Project across from Dawsons- Take fill from one place, to fill in to improve road at another place. David will look into this further, money, time, ect.

Continued:

David; Talked to Masons- See if everything up and running for emergency; David will try to check this out.

David talked to Mesick- Stratton is giving up roads that are class 4 roads- Town of Jamaica owns middle sections on some of these roads- will go thru proper procedure, notify owners.

Motion made by Bruce Chapin, seconded by David Hamilton to adjourn the meeting at 8:45 P.M.
