

TOWN OF MARLBORO SELECTBOARD DISCONTINUANCE OF A PORTION OF JENNE ROAD

On Thursday, August 24, 2006, the Selectboard met on Jenne Road at 6:00 p.m. and at the Town Office at 7:55 p.m. to consider a petition signed by landowners and voters equal to five percent of the checklist. The petition was to discontinue the portion of Jenne Road, Town Highway #44, that begins at the southern edge of the driveway to the property of Frances Bell at 703 Jenne Road and runs south to the Halifax Town Line, being in all 0.90 miles.

At the hearing on the Jenne Road site there were eight witnesses – Jack Horton, petitioner and trustee of the Ruth Jenne Forest Wildlife Trust, landowner on Jenne Road; Del Ames, nearby landowner; Mary Faith Wilson, landowner on Jenne Road; T. Hunter Wilson, nearby landowner; Patricia Wilson, resident; Bob Elliott, resident, David Elliott, road foreman; Nora Wilson, Marlboro Town Clerk.

Due notice was given by certified mail to the Commissioner of Forests, Parks and Recreation, the Marlboro Planning Commission, the Town of Halifax Selectboard, and all owners of land affected by the portion of Jenne Road, some 0.90 miles, that runs from the Bell driveway, previously described, south to the Halifax Town Line, and the subject of the hearing, at least 30 days before the date of the hearing. The Vermont Commissioner of Forests, Parks and Recreation, Agency of Natural Resources (ANR) sent a letter dated August 17, 2006 to the Selectboard which was received less than one week before the hearing. The ANR Lands Director responded to the Notice of Hearing and requested that local trail organizations such as snowmobile clubs be notified of the proposed reclassification. Immediately, certified copies of the notice of hearing were sent to the Deerfield Valley Stump Jumpers of Wilmington, VT and E-Z Riders Snowmobile Club of Jacksonville, VT. No members of those clubs were present at the hearing, nor have they contacted the Marlboro Selectboard to offer any thoughts.

The Selectboard also did cause a copy of said notice to be published on Friday, August 4, 2006 in the Brattleboro Daily Reformer, a daily newspaper having circulation in Marlboro, Vermont. A copy of such notice, as mailed, posted, published and delivered being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

During the hearing the Selectboard, and others made an inspection of the highway, riding beside the roadway right-of-way on private property, because the roadway itself was not passable by vehicle due to the thick growth of trees and vegetation, approximately 0.75 miles, then walking on the right-of-way to the edge of the Green River, which was a swampy area dammed up by beavers. This swampy area is the point at which the bridge washed out in the hurricane and flood of 1938. At this point along the right-of-way the roadway is not navigable by foot or by vehicle, and the group returned to the hearing site.

There being no further discussion, the Selectboard then drove to the Town Office to hear further testimony. No further persons appeared to offer testimony and no written testimony had been presented for consideration

After hearing all witnesses, making the inspection, and reviewing the letter and attachments from the State of Vermont, Department of Forests, Parks and Recreation, Agency of Natural Resources, which are entered into the proceedings, the Selectboard make the following

Findings of Fact

- 1. Jenne Road is a Class IV highway laid out by the Town of Marlboro in the early 1800s.
- 2. The Agency of Transportation 2003 highway map designates that portion of Jenne Road, Town Highway #44, that begins at the southern edge of the driveway to the property of Frances Bell at 703 Jenne Road and runs south to the Halifax Town line, being in all 0.90, miles untraveled and impassable.
- 3. There are three class III roads nearby that go to Halifax, namely Butterfield Road, Grant Road, and Shearer Hill Road.
- 4. Except for 800 feet along the east side of the 0.90 miles of the portion of Jenne Road subject to the hearing owned by Frances Bell, the rest of the land is owned by the Ruth Jenne Forest Wildlife Trust, Jack Horton, Trustee. No residences or camps are located on this portion of the road.
- 5. The Ruth Jenne Forest Wildlife Trust is enrolled in a Wildlife Habitat Improvement Program.
- 6. The road has not been maintained since the bridge washed out in 1938. Subsequently, beaver ponds have made the road impassable since the 1950s.
- 7. Because of the beaver ponds, people who attempt to use the road must trespass on private property because the beaver ponds block the right-of-way. This trespass has caused damage to seedings and the trustee landowner's use and enjoyment of his land.
- 8. Nearby landowners T. Hunter Wilson and Mary Faith Wilson, stated they would prefer the road be reclassified as a trail.

Consideration was given to the effect upon home and homestead rights. Based on the preceding findings, and pursuant to 19 V.S.A. §708-811, the Selectboard finds that the public good, necessity and convenience of the inhabitants require that portion of Jenne

Road, Town Highway #44, that begins at the southern edge of the driveway to the property of Frances Bell at 703 Jenne Road and runs south to the Halifax Town line, being in all 0.90, miles, be discontinued.

The petition to discontinue is therefore accepted.


