

Thank you Forrest!

That is very helpful! The lengths of the northern and western sides of the "Adams" parcel shown on Slide 110 match the GIS measures of the stone walls clearly visible in the lidar hill-shade. If the 220' to the town line is correct, then the VTrans town boundary data should be about 15' further south-ish along the TH right of way... but that's a level of detail that is minor in the grand scheme of things, especially given that we round class 3 highway mileages to the nearest 0.01 mi (almost 53')!


I've used our (VTrans) boundary data to define the centerline used to obtain the new measures for TH-40, and I've attached a simple map clarifying what is changing. The change will be preloaded onto the Marlboro Mileage Certificate when you receive it by email next week, and no additional documentation is necessary. If you or the selectboard has any questions about this, feel free to reach out to the Mapping Section!

You've probably already viewed this, but I've pasted a screen capture below that shows the parcel data (light gray lines), the VTrans boundary data (black dashed line), and the lidar hillshade. I've highlighted the western stone wall and indicated the points I used for that measurement (that matched the survey). The area indicated with the red circle probably explains the ~250' measure you mentioned. I put a small blue arrow indicating the location that is

approximately 220' from the visible stone wall (assuming that is the location of the parcel boundary, rather than the parcel data).

Thanks again for your help making our data as accurate as possible!

Hi Kerry, attached are two surveys and our tax map of parcels near the town line between Marlboro and Halifax on Cowpath 40. No survey in our records describes precisely what we are looking for.

Our tax map identifies the distance between the bottom of 12-00-66 and the town line as 250 feet. The survey says 220 feet +/- so this might account for a portion of the discrepancy. Let me know if I can be of further assistance.

Hi Kerry,

Allan who does the 911 stuff for the town and is their Fire Chief said in the email chain below, its 250 ft give or take north of where it should be. Our town line more or less matches both town tax maps. This is basically at the property line of 1954 rather than the town line. As for the mileage, checking you're your tax map it comes out to 2.12. I should have checked it first before sending along, but my arc comes out to 2.06, which is about what you mentioned.

I haven't seen the wastewater permit, but I'm inclined to think our town line is more or less correct. My main concern really is the town line sign, as any driveway near this may sway owners into thinking they are Marlboro or Halifax when they aren't.





There is definitely a mileage discrepancy...We have some extra mileage for Marlboro TH-40 (Cowpath 40), particularly in the section south of TH-41 (Barrows Rd) shown highlighted in the image below. If we have the town line in the correct location, that southern segment should probably be 0.53 mi instead of 0.57 mi, and the northern segment should probably be 1.53 mi (based on both a field inventory measurement from 1990 and to the length of our road centerline arc).

Where is the town line sign? Please let us know if you get any additional information regarding the location of the town line here! There was a DEC Wastewater permit issued for address 1954 Cowpath 40, and these permits sometimes include surveys with boundaries. However, the links to the scanned documents weren't working when I checked just now.

May have a 0.15 mileage discrepancy on Cowpath 40, Marlboro. Normally the AOT mileage and the GIS mileage line up or are fairly close, but this is about 1/8th mile off. Something to potentially flag, look into. Also may seem the town line sign is misplaced, which I have made Allan aware of, since the tax maps more or less match our line.

While I was doing the field work for the 1933/2921 change I discovered that Halifax has placed their road and speed sign about 250' north of the actual town line(as depicted on your aerials)... not your department, I know, but perhaps you know about it?
