### DECISION AND ORDER OF THE SELECTBOARD OF THE TOWN OF ROCKINGHAM, VERMONT FOR THE WIDENING AND RECLASSIFICATION OF TOWN HIGHWAY # 58, OSGOOD ROAD

Beginning at 6:00 p.m. on June 3, 2008, the Selectboard held a site inspection, and at 7:00 p.m. on June 3, 2008, held a hearing for the purpose of taking testimony of interested persons, and adjoining landowners, as to whether the public good, necessity and convenience of the inhabitants of the municipality required that a portion of <u>T.H. #58, Osgood Road</u>, be reclassified and widened.

Legal notice was given by certified mail to all owners and interested persons at least 30 days before the date of the hearing including as follows: James E. Mullen Trust UA Dated 8/4/82, Emmett N. Shutts Trust, Anitra and Lyle Sorensen, Frederick and Nancy Stein, Joel and Nancy Becker, Green Mountain Power Company, the Bank of New York, United State Trust Company of New York, Fleet National Bank, Citizens Bank of Massachusetts, Fairpoint Communications, Comcast, and via hand delivery to the Rockingham Planning Commission.

Notice was also published in the Eagle Times on May 1, 2008, and posted as required by Statute.

During the site inspection, the Selectboard walked a portion of the highway. The following persons were present at the site inspection: Selectboard members Thomas MacPhee, Ann DiBernardo, Dennis Harty and Peter Golec. Also present were James Mullen, Municipal Manager; Ellen Howard, Planning & Zoning Administrator; and Stan Davis, FACT TV.

The following persons were present at the hearing: Selectboard members Thomas MacPhee, Ann DiBernardo, Dennis Harty, Peter Golec and Robert Thomson. Also present were Ellen Howard, and Stan Davis.

After hearing the witnesses, and making the inspection, the Selectboard makes the following findings of fact:

- 1. Osgood Road is a class 3 Town highway for a distance of 0.44 miles per the Vermont Agency of Transportation Town of Rockingham Highway Map. The remainder of Osgood Road is a class 4 road.
- 2. The Selectboard, on its own motion, proposed to widen a portion of Osgood Road to create a turn-around, and to reclassify a portion of Osgood Road from class 4 to class 3 beginning at a point approximately 1,950 ft. west of the intersection with Parker Hill Road. The reclassified portion would become part of the turn-around.
- 3. The area to be widened and reclassified is shown on a plan entitled "Reclassification and Layout of a Portion of Osgood Road" prepared by DiBernardo Associates, dated December 20, 2002, dwg. No. 2069-2.

- 4. Two parcels of land are affected by the widening and reclassification. These parcels are owned by the James Mullen Trust UA Dated 8/4/82 and Trustees of the Emmett N. Shutts Trust.
- 5. There are four residences on the road. The class 4 portion of the road continues through the Mullen property and runs westerly to the Brockways Mills Road. The westerly portion is known as the Frederick Read Road. Some portions are not passable by vehicle.
- 6. An informal turn-around has been utilized by Town trucks at the end of the class 3 portion of the highway for many years. As proposed, the turn-around would be a portion of the laid-out town highway.
- 7. The Mullen Trust notified the Town via e-mail dated April 12, 2008, from Sherie Welch, Trustee, that it would not seek damages for the land required for the Osgood Road turnaround. The Shutts Trust notified the Town via e-mail dated May 28, 2008 that it would not seek damages and was in favor of the reclassification and layout of the town highway.

As no damages are requested, none are awarded.

Based on the preceding findings, and pursuant to 19 V.S.A. sections 708-711, the Selectboard finds that the public good, necessity and convenience of the inhabitants require that a portion of T.H. #58, Osgood Road, be widened and reclassified from a class 4 to a class 3 Town-highway as shown on a plan entitled "Reclassification and Layout of a Portion of Osgood Road" prepared by DiBernardo Associates, dated December 20, 2002, dwg. No. 2069-2. So voted June 3, 2008. A mylar copy of the survey is to be recorded in the Rockingham Land Records.




