


§ 305. Measurement and inspection


- (a) After reasonable notice to the selectboard, a representative of the agency may measure and inspect the class 1, 2, and 3 town highways in each town to verify the accuracy of the records on file with the agency. Upon request, the selectboard or their designee shall be permitted to accompany the representative of the agency during the measurement and inspection. The agency shall notify the town when any highway, or portion of a highway, does not meet the standards for its assigned class. If the town fails, within one year, to restore the highway or portion of the highway to the accepted standard, or to reclassify, or to discontinue, or develop an acceptable schedule for restoring to the accepted standards, the agency for purposes of apportionment under section 306 of this title shall deduct the affected mileage from that assigned to the town for the particular class of the road in question.
- (b) Annually, on or before February 10, the selectboard shall file with the town clerk a sworn statement of the description and measurements of all class 1, 2, 3, and 4 town highways and trails then in existence, including any special designation such as a throughway or scenic highway. When class 1, 2, 3, or 4 town highways, trails, or unidentified corridors are accepted, discontinued, or reclassified, a copy of the proceedings shall be filed in the town clerk's office and a copy shall be forwarded to the agency.
- (c) All class 1, 2, 3, and 4 town highways and trails shall appear on the town highway maps by July 1, 2015.
- (d) At least 45 days prior to first including a town highway or trail that is not clearly observable by physical evidence of its use as a highway or trail and that is legally established prior to February 10, 2006 in the sworn statement required under subsection (b) of this section, the legislative body of the municipality shall provide written notice and an opportunity to be heard at a duly warned meeting of the legislative body to persons owning lands through which a highway or trail passes or abuts.
- (e) The agency shall not accept any change in mileage until the records required to be filed in the town clerk's office by this section are received by the agency. A request by a municipality to the agency for a change in mileage shall include a description of the affected highway or trail, a copy of any surveys of the affected highway or trail, minutes of meetings at which the legislative body took action with respect to the changes, and a current town highway map with the requested deletions and additions sketched on it. A survey shall not be required for class 4 town highways that are legally established prior to February 10, 2006. All records filed with the agency are subject to verification in accordance with subsection (a) of this section.
- (f) The selectboard of any town who are aggrieved by a finding of the agency concerning the measurement, description, or classification of a town highway may appeal to the transportation board by filing a notice of appeal with the executive secretary of the transportation board.
- (g) The agency shall provide each town with a map of all of the highways in that town together with the mileage of each class 1, 2, 3, and 4 highway, as well as each trail, and such other information as the agency deems appropriate.



Thank you for sending the documents on March 13. I have a couple of follow up questions about Old Acton Rd and Bush Way.

OLD ACTON RD

On the Mileage Certificate 0.816 miles of Legal Trail is to be added. I am assuming that this is to be associated with Old Acton Rd. I plotted up the location of Old Acton Rd based on the survey titled "Plan of Old Acton Rd from Windham Hill Road to Tannery Brook". Please see the enclosed file titled Townshend_OldActon. Based on the survey, the mileage total I am coming up with is 0.91 miles. Please review this and let me know if I have interpreted Townshend's intention with the road and if I should use 0.91 miles or 0.82 (rounded up from 0.816).

BUSH WAY

The Mileage Certificate notes a discontinuance of Bush Way. The only road segment called "Bush Way" that I can find in our data is a Trail (about 0.37 mi) in the southeast corner of Townshend (see enclosed file titled Townshend_BushWy). Is this the right-of-way to be discontinued?

ON HEARING HELD MAY 17, 1991

On May 17, 1991 at 7:00 PM a hearing was held at the Townshend Elementary School for the purpose of hearing all parties interested in the Petition:

"Pursuant to Title 19, Section 708, we the undersigned petition the Selectmen of the Town of Townshend to discontinue to following described public highway, as it has not been highway for many years.

That part of the highway that was laid out October 6, 180 Selectmen of the Town of Acton that runs from a point near northeast corner of land owned by Walter M. Woodruff (Vol. Page 48) through land owned by Fernand and Debra A. Cyr to property line of the Rocks and Rills Association."

to the Townshend Board of Selectmen to discontinue that portion of the Old Acton Road as described in the Acton Town Records, 1801-1835, Page 13.

Notice of this hearing was duly served by mail in timely fashion upon all persons owning or interested in lands through which the subject road passes and to all persons owning or interested in lands abutting the subject road. A copy of the notice was published in the Brattleboro Reformer not less than 10 days prior to the hearing, and a copy of the notice was placed in at least 5 conspicuous places within the town, including the office of the Town Clerk. At the aforesaid hearing, all interested parties and their attorneys were given ample opportunity to be heard. Prior and subsequent to the aforesaid hearing, the Board of Selectmen individually and collectively inspected the road subject to their petition.

At the hearing, numerous objections were raised to the discontinuance of the subject road by abutting property owners (other than the petitioners), residents of Townshend and residents of surrounding towns. It was represented to the Selectmen by Counsel for several abutting property owners (other than the petitioners) that discontinuing the road would deny them and the taxpayers of Townshend access to a valuable recreational asset that would be lost forever.

In light of the objections raised, based upon the evidence presented to them during their inspection and at the hearing, and as a result of their deliberation and investigation, the Selectmen made the following findings:

- 1. The petitioners have not proven that the greater public good would be served by discontinuing the road.
- 2. It was represented to the Selectmen by Counsel that the road should be surveyed regardless of the Selectmen's decision.
- 3. Board of Selectmen accepted the survey prepared by James C. Ferguson, registered land surveyor, performed June, 1991 as to the location of the road described in Acton Town Records, 1801-1835, Page 13; running between Windham Hill Road (Town Highway #3) and the Tannery Brook.
- 4. The recreational value of the road, while limited in scope and value, regardless takes precedence over the financial gains of the petitioner(s).
- 5. The historical significance of the last known east-west connection between Windham Hill Road and Acton Hill is significant enough for the Town to maintain a right-of-way.

Based upon the foregoing, it is the opinion of the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Townshend that the public good, necessity and convenience of the inhabitants of the Town requires denying the petition to discontinue the road in question.
