budget for Franklin Road and \$80,000.00 for Stebbins Road. After further discussion it was decided to put an Article in the Warning to raise and appropriate \$100,000.00 to be placed in the Road Upgrade Fund. This would enable the monies to be spent should the survey be completed, but if not, the funds would not have to be raised next year. The remaining \$180,000.00 will remain in the budget.

PETER SKIBNIOWSKY MADE THE MOTION TO HAVE BILL HAMMOND AT THE SCHOOL MEETING TO ADDRESS THE TOWNSPEOPLE AT THE BEGINNING OF THE MEETING AND EXPLAIN WHAT IS ANTICIPATED FROM VERMONT YANKEE AND HOW MUCH INCREASE TO THE TOWN IS EXPECTED. FURTHER, THAT BILL ADDRESS THE TOWNSPEOPLE WHEN THE MEETING GOES INTO THE TOWN PORTION AND AGAIN ON TUESDAY EVENING ON THE SAME SUBJECT. DON HOLLAND SECONDED THE MOTION. VOTE CALLED FOR: IN THE AFFIRMATIVE: MOTION CARRIED.

Don suggested Bill prepare a sheet for distribution at the polls for information.

Don Holland stated, and the Board agreed, he would like to see more of the large money expenditure items, like the Elderly Housing, done earlier in the evening, saving the committee reports for later.

ADMINISTRATOR'S UPDATE

CERTIFICATE OF HIGHWAY MILEAGE

Dick Taylor researched the mileage question raised at the previous meeting. The figures were remeasured by Jay Kilton in 1990 and the total of mileage that resulted was lower because the 1986 figures had been incorrect. In 1991 all the new roads were added, but due to the readjustment, the mileage difference expressed was only a little over a mile from the miscalculated 1986 figures. The Agency was advised of the Ad Brook and Lillis Pasture reclassification from Class IV to Trail, but the Agency includes Trails in the Class IV category.

The total miles of highway, per the Certificate of Highway Mileage, is 36.372 miles.

DON HOLLAND MADE THE MOTION TO HAVE THE WHOLE BOARD SIGN THE CERTIFICATE OF HIGHWAY MILEAGE FORM. PETER SKIBNIOWSKY SECONDED THE MOTION. VOTE CALLED FOR: IN THE AFFIRMATIVE: MOTION CARRIED.

The signed Certificate was given to the Town Clerk.

COLLER PARCEL - RECREATION AREA

Dale Dintaman has informed Mrs. Northup that the third lot of the Collar Lot (so called) in the development of

ADMINISTRATOR'S UPDATE

VACANCIES ON BOARD OF SELECTMEN

Don Holland read the following statement: "Mr. Chairman, we have received four volunteers to fill the open positions of Selectmen for the rest of the year until March 3, 1992. Mr. Sturtevant, Mr. Waite, Mr. Dunklee, and Mr. Dyer. Mr. Gillis of the Secretary of State's office advised us that there was no restrictions of a Special Police Officer filling this position, but advised that he should abstain from matters concerning the Police Department. Since we may soon be in the position of filling the Police Chief's position, this could be detrimental to the Board. Therefore:

I MOVE THAT WE APPOINT MR. CONRAD WAITE AND MR. COURTLAND DUNKLEE TO THE UNEXPIRED TERMS OF TWO ONE YEAR SELECTMEN POSITIONS UNTIL MARCH 3, 1992, WRIT A LETTER TO THE TOWN CLERK INFORMING HER OF THE ACTION, AND A LETTER TO MR. WAITE AND MR. DUNKLEE INFORMING THEM OF THE APPOINTMENTS SO THEY MAY HAVE THE OATH OF OFFICE ADMINISTERED BY THE TOWN CLERK." He further stated he felt the Board owed it to the Town to fill these two positions and have a full board for the rest of the year. Both men are willing to serve. Peter Skibniowsky refused to second the motion until the applicants apply in writing. The motion died for lack of a second.

CERTIFICATE OF HIGHWAY MILEAGE

The Certificate of Highway Mileage has been checked by the Road Commissioner and agreed with. PETER SKIBNIOWSKY MADE THE MOTION TO SIGN THE CERTIFICATE OF HIGHWAY MILEAGE. Don Holland and Walter Zaluzny compared the figures on the form with those on a 1986 Highway map on the bulletin board, and requested that Mrs. Northup have Mr. Taylor go over the figures again to see why there is only one mile increase in the last five years, when they know there is more than that. Peter Skibniowsky withdrew his motion.
