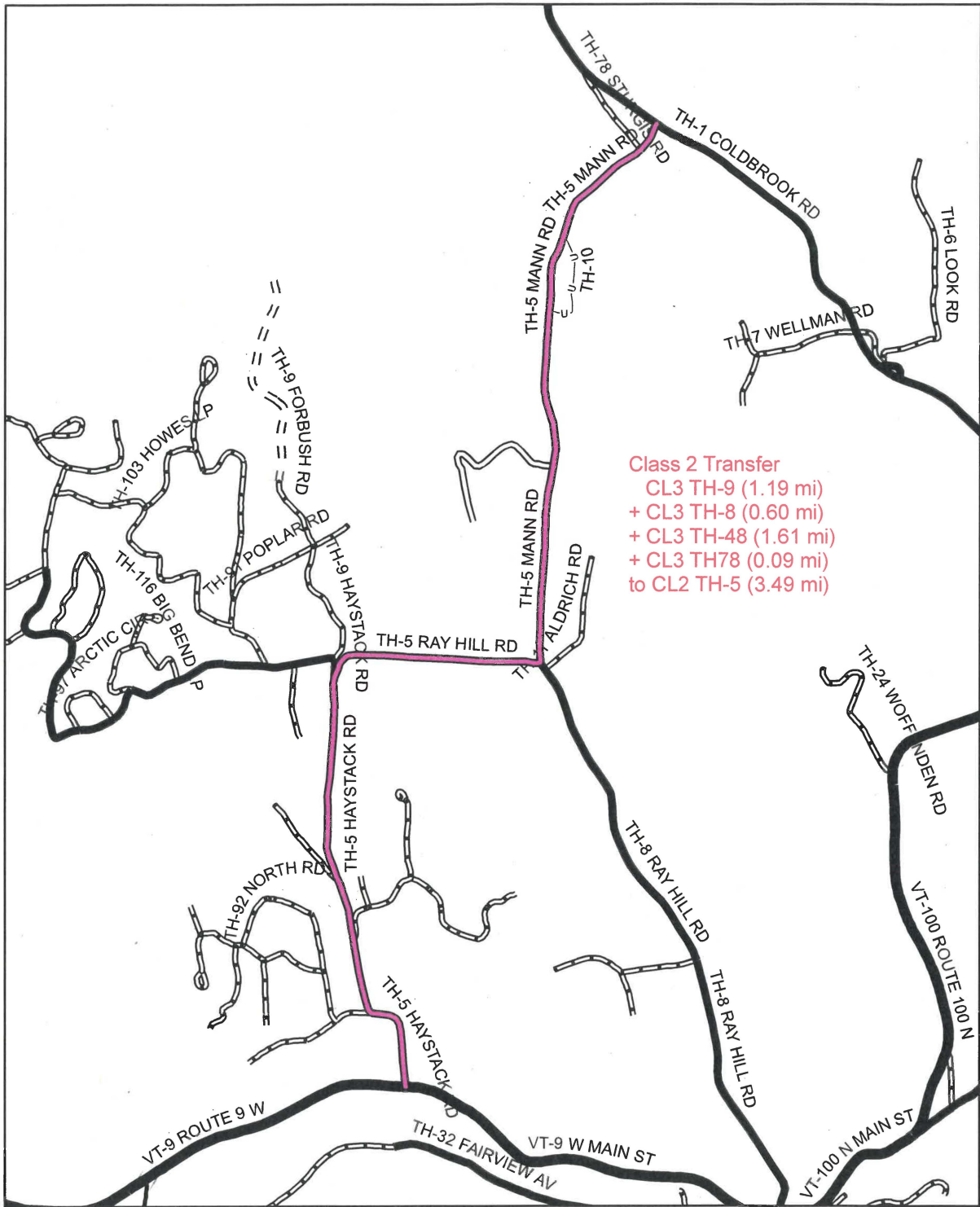

I received your letter detailing changes in the surface type of several town highways in Wilmington. Thank you for this information. It is very helpful feedback for us.

#### TH-28 Larson Rd

I've incorporated all the changes except the one associated with TH-28 Larson Rd. It looks like the town would like to extend what is mapped as gravel another 0.07 miles for a total of 0.40 miles. However, TH-28 is currently listed as 0.33 miles long, followed by a discontinued section.

In reviewing our records of the history of this road, it appears that before 1974 TH-28 was 0.53 miles long with a gate at 0.40 miles. In 1974, TH-28 was recorded as being 0.40 miles long with a discontinued section following.

In 1981, the 0.40-mile section was reduced to 0.33-miles through a remeasurement. Based on our orthophotos and your note that the gravel surface extends 0.40 miles, it appears that TH-28 actually does extend for the full 0.40 miles.

In order to accommodate the surface change request, the town should submit a remeasurement change to add the 0.07 miles in its Certificate of Highway Mileage.

#### TH-25 Ware Rd / Old Stage Rd

On the spreadsheet that was enclosed with your surface change list, it was noted that the town was not sure how much mileage of the Class 4 section of TH-25 was assigned to Ware Rd and how much was assigned to Old Stage Rd. I've enclosed a sketch map of how the assignment is currently recorded in our road centerline data. This assignment is based on E911 road centerline data.

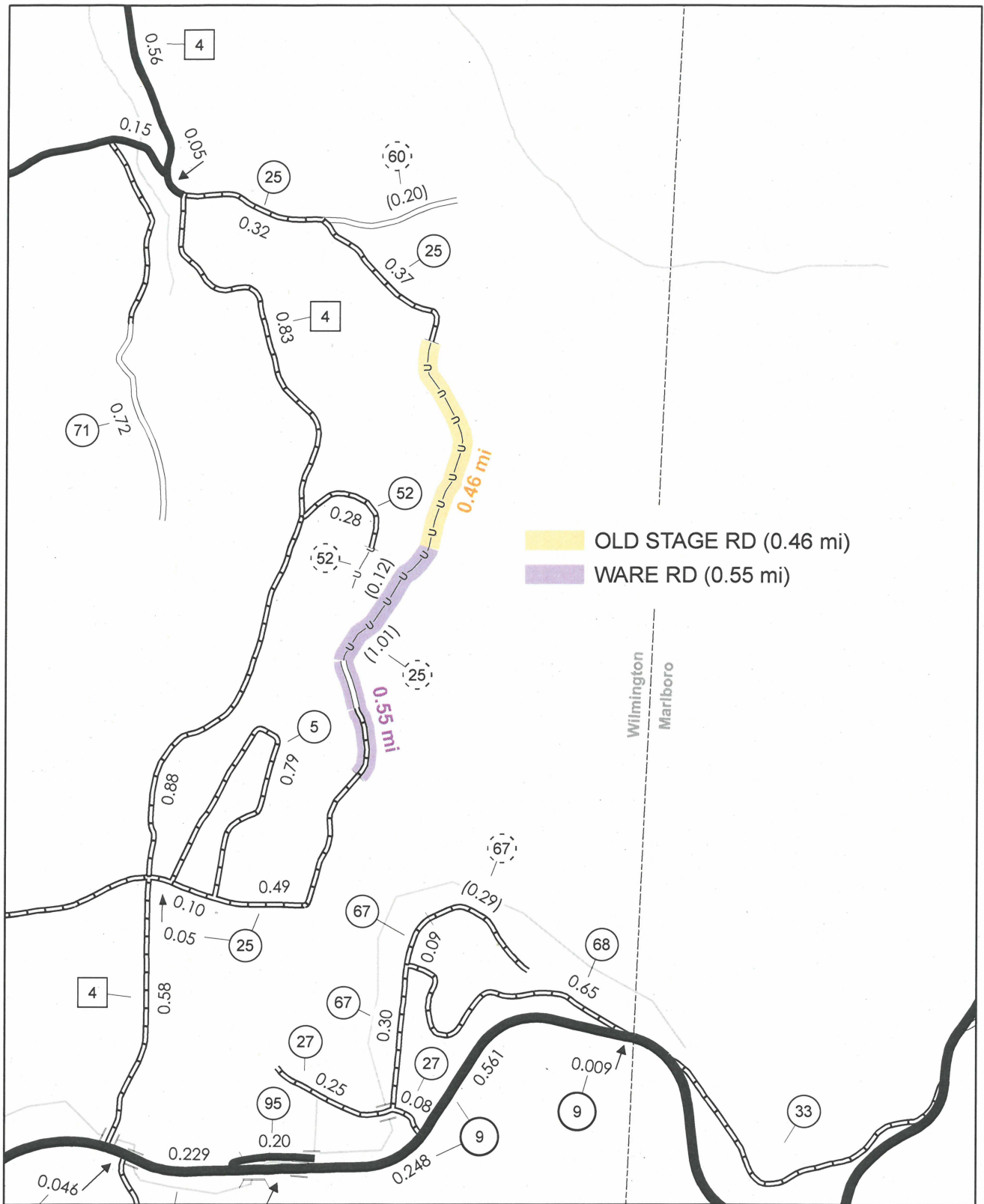

Dear Ms. Moulton:

Out Road Supervisor Bill Hunt reviewed the 2007 Town Map you sent in November. There have been several changes in road surfaces that are marked and highlighted on the attached map.

Changes are as follows:

1. TH # 40 Shearer Hill Road: Paved 4100' (.78 mi) section at Rt 9 end of Road (North end)
2. TH # 96 Abbie Lane Road is all gravel, not paved as marked on map
3. TH #31 New England Power Road Road is all gravel, not paved as marked on map
4. TH #17 Haynes Road The .45 section of road on the eastern end of road is marked partly graded earth on map, but is all gravel.
5. TH #52 Stearns Avenue Road is all gravel, not graded earth as marked on map
6. TH #9 Haystack Road The .20 Section at the north end of the road is all gravel, not graded earth as marked on map
7. TH #19 Steep Hill Road .14 of the class 4 section at the end that abuts TH 17 is now graded earth and traveled.
8. TH #28 Larson Road Gravel extended .07 at end of road
9. TH #25- S Ware Road Add .06 to graveled portion at the graded earth section marked on map at south end of the class 4 section.

I have also enclosed a spreadsheet that may help identify the changes.
