# RECLASSIFICATION OF OLD PARMALEE ROAD (TH #52) JUNE 12, 2023

On Monday, June 12, 2023 a site visit and duly warned public hearing were held to consider the reclassification of Old Parmalee Road, TH #52. It is shown on State of Vermont Highway Maps as being .07 miles in length and Class 3.

The Selectboard was in receipt of a request by the Vermont Agency of Transportation to reclassify the road or bring it up to the standards of a Class 3 road as it is currently classified. See attached.

The abutting landowners, Chris & Kathleen Meyer and Alison Minor, were notified as required by statute. Neither abutter brought forward any objections or feedback as to the reclassification and did not attend the public hearing. There were no objections brought by the public present at the hearing.

On a motion by Melissa Gates-Perry, seconded by Chris Plumb, the Board approved the discontinuance of TH #52, Old Parmalee Road, laid out on May 24, 1833 and described in Andover Town Records Volume 3, Page 13 as follows:

"Beginning in the center of the said Manchester Road... North 51 degrees West four rods thence North 89 degrees West nine rods thence North 40 degrees West 10 rods"

# RECLASSIFICATION OF OLD GULF ROAD SOUTH (TH #13) OCTOBER 30, 2023

On Monday, October 30, 2023 a site visit and duly warned public hearing were held to consider the reclassification of Old Gulf Road South, TH #13. It is shown on State of Vermont Highway Maps as being .86 miles in length and Class 3. It was being considered for reclassification because according to Road Foreman, Charlie Golden, it is not up to Class 3 Standards.

The Selectboard was in receipt of emails from Johnathan Croft & Meghan Brunk, both of the Vermont Agency of Transportation, which provided an explanation of highway standards, statutes regarding these standards, & the reclassification process.

The abutting landowners, Gerald & Ann Janauer (Horseshoe Acres Campground), East Hill Adventures (Will Clarke), Richard & Deborah Simmons, Vermont Land Trust and Lauren Jarvis and George Rametta were notified as required by statute. Mr. Jarvis and Mr. Clarke both communicated prior to the hearing they had no concerns with reclassification of the road.

Chris Plumb convened the public hearing at 4:57 p.m. at the Town Office and asked for a motion about reclassifying Old Gulf Road South. Richard Griswold moved to reclassify the road from a Class 3 to a Class 4 road. It was seconded by Melissa Gates-Perry. The Board unanimously approved the reclassification from a Class 3 to a Class 4 of TH #13, Old Gulf Road South, which was laid out on May 8, 1857 and described in Andover Town Records Volume 3, Page 449-450 as follows:

"Beginning at a point for the center of the said highway five rods and 15 links from the southeast corner of Albert Parkhurst's dwelling house and on the north side of the highway leading from Chester to Weston in a course South 83 degrees East four rods thence North 12 degrees East for 49 rods...."

# TOWN OF ANDOVER SELECT BOARD PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES November 27, 2023

Select Board Members Present: Chris Plumb, Richard Griswold, Susan Leader, Melissa Gates-Perry, & Robin Trask

Select Board Members Absent: None

**Public present:** Fred & Patty Linck, Alison Kinchla, Russell Newman, Hank Mauti, Jonathan Stevens, Rob Israel & Chris Byrne (via Zoom), Sarah Bennett of *Okemo Valley TV*, & Jeanette Haight, clerk.

- 1. Site visits were held at Markham Mountain Road, Marsh Cross Road, & Israel Roads beginning at 3:00 p.m.
- 2. Hearing: Chris Plumb called the hearing to order at 4.05 p.m. at the Town Office. The agenda was accepted as written on a motion by Richard Griswold, seconded by Melissa Gates-Perry. Chris asked for a motion to reclassify Markham Mountain Road. Robin Trask & Susan Leader both asked to have discussion first before any motion was made. Chris agreed then went over the reasons Road Foreman, Charlie Golden, had suggested the road be reclassified. Russell Newman & Alison Kinchla, new owners of a camp at the end of Markham Mountain Road, were present and asked that the road remain a Class 3 and be maintained year-round. They stated they are new owners of the property and the purchase price and taxes were justified by the fact the property is on a town-maintained road (which they said the former owner told them repeatedly). Susan said she personally needed more information before taking any action to better understand how other similar roads in town would be handled. After a lengthy discussion about winter maintenance, real estate value, safety, VAST access and insurability, Chris asked if anyone wanted to make a motion. Robin said she was "bouncing around about what to do". Richard pointed out the road has not been maintained in the winter so taking it on would be a big undertaking. Ms. Kinchla asked if the town could "bank in" 20 feet or so when Middletown Road is being plowed just to help them with access. Melissa noted the Board was not in a position to make "special arrangements" with property owners. After more discussion, Chris moved to reclassify Markham Mountain Road from a Class 3 to a Class 4. Melissa seconded. The motion passed with one abstention.

Marsh Cross Road — Richard said he thought most people are under the impression that Marsh Cross is already a Class 4 Road, rather than a Class 3. Chris Byrne, a representative for Markham Mountain LLC, was present via Zoom and reiterated the organization's desire to have the road discontinued since they own the property all around it. Richard said he didn't like the idea of giving up the Town's right-of-way as the road is used extensively for walking. He wondered about making it a Legal trail. Mr. Byrne wondered if they, as the landowners around it, would be able to continue using motorized vehicles on the road if it were declassified to a Legal trail. Chris said yes they could. Susan asked why they wouldn't just make it a Class 4 road. Richard moved to reclassify Marsh Cross Road from a Class 3 to a Class 4 road. Melissa seconded. So moved.

Israel Road – Fred & Patty Linck were present to ask that Israel Road be left as a Class 3 and continue to be maintained in the winter. She said although they maintain the rest of the road (the private section). They don't have the proper equipment to maintain the .12 mile section that is currently Class 3. Mr. Linck said the berm that is left at the end of the road when Little Pond gets plowed is impossible for him to push with the equipment he has. Rob Israel, the property owner who was present via Zoom, said the Lincks are full-time residents and "they need daily access". Susan again stated she wasn't ready to make a decision and acknowledged the "human element" involved in a situation like this where a decision is based on "non-human policy". Chris said the road isn't even close to meeting Class 3 standards, but suggested the town could plow it for this winter as it has always been maintained in the past. Mr. Israel asked if he paid to have it brought up to Class 3 standards, would the town consider leaving it a Class 3. Melissa clarified this road has been maintained in the winter, whereas Markham Mountain Road has not, which is why they are being handled differently. Richard moved to table discussion about Israel Road's classification until spring. Melissa seconded. So moved.

3. Richard moved to adjourn the hearing at 5:15 p.m. Susan seconded. So moved.





Hi Jeanette,

Thank you so much for all of this. We also recommend that the Town notify the Vermont Department of Parks, Forests, and Recreation regarding the discontinuance of TH-52 (Old Parmalee Rd) to ensure that they have no objections. They should receive notice as they like to weigh in on whether a road could become a Legal Trail or not.

If you could please provide us with a copy of your email/letter to them so we can include it in our records.

For TH-13 (Old Gulf Rd.), the length description you sent in the decision does not match up with the mileage that we have mapped or what is in the attached inventory. We have the Class 3 mileage as 0.86 as noted in the top of your document for TH-13 (see yellow highlight in image below) and the inventory notes 0.84 miles. However, the description in the notes at the bottom of the decision lists the length in the survey as 4 rods + 49 rods = 0.17 miles. Is this the correct survey/description? From the document it sounds like you are describing the road in its entirety but the survey notes do not match that. Are you just reclassifying a 0.17-mile section of the road? If so, we will need more detail on the beginning and end of the reclassification or to not have the survey description in there and just mention the entirety.
