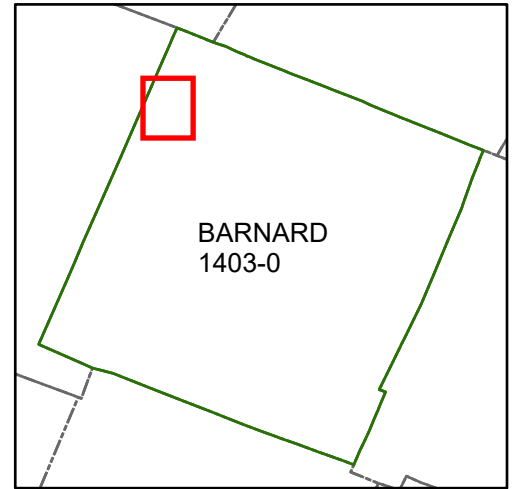
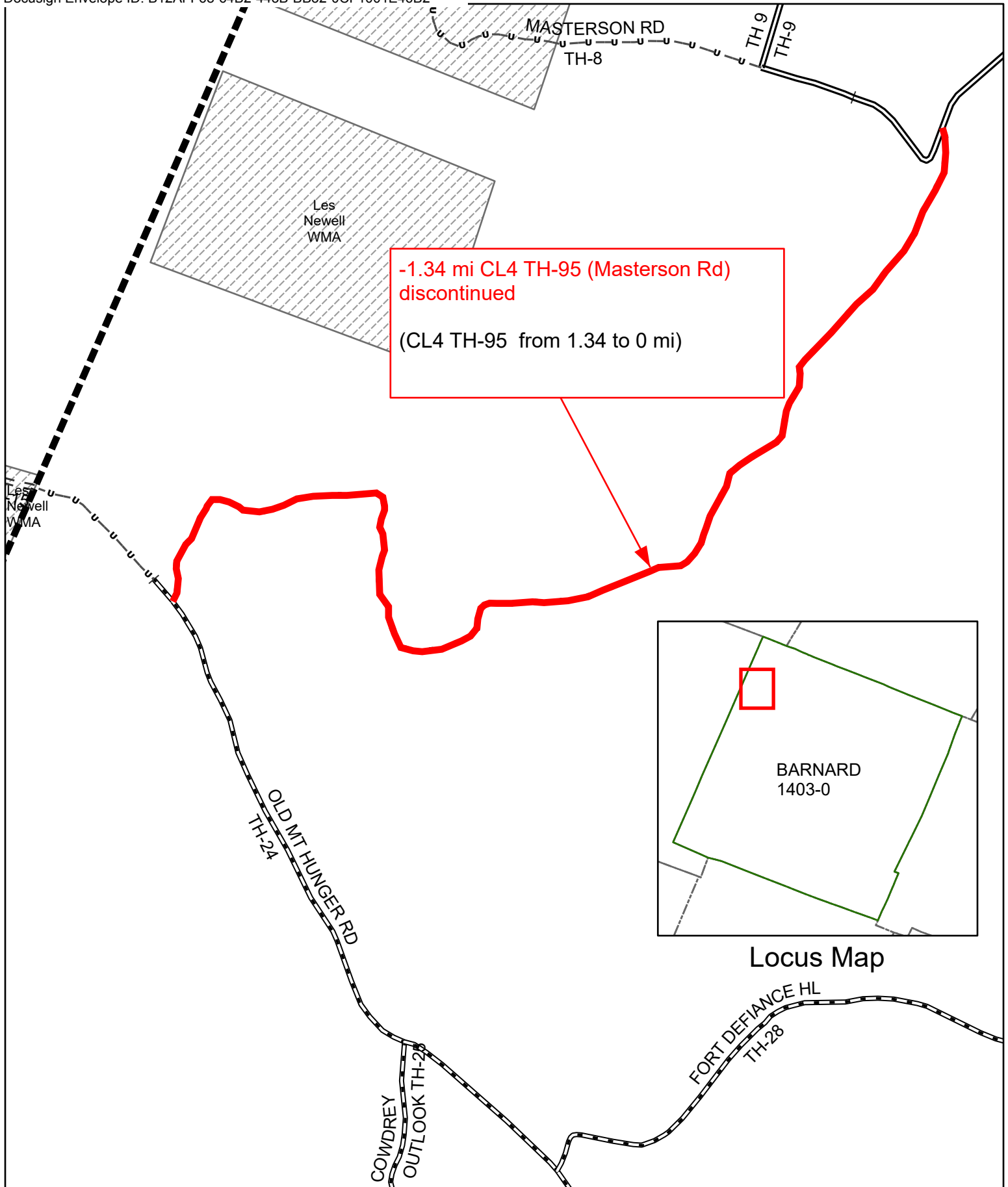

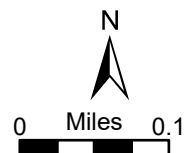


Locus Map

**TOWN OF BARNARD, VERMONT
ORDER OF DISCONTINUANCE
TOWN HIGHWAY 95**

WHEREAS, on April 22, 2024, the Town of Barnard Selectboard, on its own motion, initiated proceedings to consider discontinuing the Class IV portion of Masterson Road (TH 95), in its entire length, from the intersection with the Class III portion of Masterson Road (TH8) to the intersection with Old Mount Hunger Road (TH24).

WHEREAS, notices of the time and date for examining the premises and hearing date to persons interested were sent in accordance with 19 V.S.A. §§709 and 775, namely by mailing notice via certified mail to each interested person at least thirty days in advance, by giving notice to the Barnard Planning Commission and the Vermont Department of Forests, Parks, and Recreation, by posting a copy of the notice in the office of the Barnard Town Clerk, and by causing a copy of the notice to be published in the Valley News, a local newspaper of general circulation in the area, not less than ten days before the time set for the hearing; and,

WHEREAS, on June 5, 2024, the Selectboard conducted an examination of the premises and held a public hearing where it took testimony regarding whether the discontinuance would serve the public good, necessity, and convenience of the inhabitants of the Town of Barnard;

NOW, THEREFORE, based upon the inspection and the evidence presented at the hearing, the Barnard Selectboard makes the following findings of fact:

1. Town Highway 95 is a Class 4 town highway called Masterson Road.
3. Town Highway 95 is minimally traveled and receives little or no public use. As a Class 4 town highway, Town Highway 95 receives no maintenance and is not plowed by the Town.
4. None of the abutting property owners, the Barnard Planning Commission, or the Vermont Department of Forest, Parks, and Recreation have provided any objection to the proposed discontinuance of Town Highway 95.
5. Discontinuing Town Highway 95 will relieve the Town of any future obligation to maintain or upgrade the road, thereby reducing the burden on Barnard taxpayers.
6. No party will be entitled to damages due to the discontinuance of Town Highway 95. Damages are not available in the case of a discontinuance because the abutting property owners are not relinquishing or being deprived of property rights.


WHEREFORE, based on these findings, and pursuant to 19 V.S.A. §710, the Selectboard concludes that discontinuance of Town Highway 95 will serve the public good, necessity, and convenience of the inhabitants of the Town of Barnard, and orders that Town Highway 95 is hereby discontinued in its entire length from the intersection with the Class III portion of Masterson Road (TH8) to the intersection with Old Mount Hunger Road (TH24).

This Order and its incorporated findings, together with a copy of the minutes of the Selectboard's June 5, 2025 meeting, shall be filed with the Barnard Town Clerk for recording. A copy of this Order shall also be mailed, via first-class mail, to each person who received written notice of the Selectboard's June 5, 2024, examination and hearing.



Masterson Road Discontinuance Hearing Minutes

June 5, 2024

Notice of Hearing and Site Inspection for Discontinuance of the Class IV section of the Masterson Road (TH95) as legally warned 4/17/24

Site inspection, 6:00pm to 6:15pm, at the beginning of the Class IV section of Masterson Road.

The Selectboard met with Glen Dunning to discuss the discontinuance of the Class IV portion of the Masterson Road. Glen was in favor of the discontinuance and asked about signage. The Selectboard noted that they would place an End of Town Road sign at the end of the Class III portion of the Masterson Road and remove the existing Class IV notification sign.


Formal hearing, 7:20pm - 7:22pm, at the Barnard Town Hall.

During the hearing at the Town Hall Mr. Bruce Dougherty, a landowner abutting the Class IV portion of Masterson Road, declared that he had no reservations about discontinuing the road. There were no other public comments on the discontinuance and the Selectboard voted to discontinue the Class 4 portion of Masterson Road (Town Highway No. 95) in its entire length from the intersection with Class 3 Masterson Road (Town Highway 8) to the to the intersection with Old Mount Hunger Road (Town Highway 24).


**Notice of Hearing and Site Inspection
Discontinuance of the Class 4 portion Masterson Road (T.H. 95)**

The Selectboard of the Town of Barnard hereby gives notice to owners or persons interested in lands and rights that may be affected by a decision of the Selectboard to discontinue the Class 4 portion of Masterson Road (Town Highway No. 95) in its entire length from the intersection with Class 3 Masterson Road (Town Highway 8) to the intersection with Old Mount Hunger Road (Town Highway 24).

The Selectboard will meet at the intersection of Class 3 Masterson Road and Class 4 Masterson Road at 6:00 PM on June 5, 2024 to inspect Class 4 Masterson Road and thereafter meet at the Barnard Town Hall at 115 North Road, Barnard, Vermont, at approximately 7:00 PM to conduct a hearing and receive testimony on the question of discontinuing Masterson Road.

As required by 19 V.S.A. §709, 30 days' notice of this site inspection and hearing is being provided by certified mail to each of the persons owning or interested in lands through which this highway may pass or abut, listed below, as well as the Barnard Planning Commission, and the Commissioner of the Vermont Department of Forests and Parks. A copy will be posted in the office of the Barnard Town Clerk, and published in the Valley News not less than 10 days before the time set for the hearing.


