The Notice of Public Hearing, as it appeared in the August 16, 2006 Message of The Week.

Mr. Jewett opened the Hearing by stating that Robert and Marcia Mayoh have asked that the Town discontinue Town Road 95, known as Lovell Road, off Town Road 53, Richardson Road.

Robert and Marcia Mayoh stated that the road went right in front of their house and between their house and their barn. They understood that, being discontinued, the Town would no longer maintain the road.

They also testified that their property abutted both sides of the road in its entirety.

There was some concern as to whether, in fact, the Mayohs owned the small triangle of land between Richardson and Lovell Road given the Town Tax Map described it as being a portion of the Grob land on the west side of Richardson Road. The Mayohs presented documents showing that they clearly owned the land in question

Ms. Spaulding testified that she had discussed the discontinuance with Graham Kennedy and he had no objections.

Keith Hill testified that the road was difficult to plow and it would be much easier just to plow up Richardson Road

Mr. Hill made the motion to discontinue Lovell Road, Mr. LeClair seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Notice of the Hearing was published in the Message for the Week on August 16, 2006 and copies posted in the Town Clerk's Office, on the Town Hall Bulletin Board and at Chester Post Office.
 - 2, The following interested parties were given notice by certified mail:

Robert and Marcia Mayoh Douglas Grob

- 3. The Planning Commission was given notice of the hearing.
- 4. The highway map of the Town of Chester shows Lovell Road as Town Highway 95 being a 0.14 Class 3 road beginning and ending on Town Highway 53, Richardson Road
- 5. Section 292, Chapter 7, Title 19 Vermont Statutes Annotated states that, as the convenience of the inhabitants and the public good requires, Selectmen shall lay out, alter and discontinue highways.
- 6. When a highway is discontinued, title to the property is set out in Section 535, Chapter 7, Title 19 Vermont Statutes Annotated.
- 7. The highway to be discontinued lies solely within property owned by the Robert and Marcia Mayoh.
- 8. That after hearing all interested parties, a majority of the Selectmen judge that the convenience of the inhabitants and the public good require that the Class 3 Road known as Lovell Road be discontinued.
 - 9. That no damages be awarded to the owners of the land adjoining the highway.

10. That the title to the discontinued portion of the Class 3 highway be set and belong to the owner of the adjoining lands.

SELECTMEN'S ORDER OF DOING

The Selectmen, Town of Chester, Vermont, County of Windsor, hereby order:

- 1. That the class 3 highway shown as Town Highway 93 on the Town Highway Map be discontinued.
- 2. That no damages be awarded to the owners of land adjoining this section of the Town Highway.
- 3. That title to the discontinued portion of the Class 3 highway be set and belong to the owners of adjoining lands.
 - 4. That all adjoining property owners be provided a copy of this order by certified mail.
- 5. That a copy of this Hearing and Order shall be filed with the Town Clerk and entered into the Chester Town Road Book.

APPEAL PROCEDURES;

1. Section 381, Title 19, Vermont Statutes Annotated:

If the award of damages by the Selectmen is not acceptable to the property owner the Selectmen may agree to refer the question of damages to one or more disinterested persons, whose award shall be final. Such reference and award, and the proceedings in settling the damages, shall be stated in the doings of the Selectmen and returned to the Town Clerk.

2. Section 382, Title 19, Vermont Statutes Annotated:

When a person interested in lands through which Selectmen have laid or altered a higway is not satisfied with the damages offered by the Selectmen, or when damages are not offered and a reference thereof is not agreed upon, by petition, in writing, he may apply to a district judge for the appointment of commissioners to appraise the damages. Any persons claiming damages on account of such highway may join in the petition, but such petition shall not delay the opening of the highway.
