No comments from citizens.

Ranta Road Update:

A letter dated June 8, 1990 from Ron Parry and a letter dated June 15, 1998 from Michael Kraatz were read and discussed. Michael Kraatz noted a correction in his letter stating that a 75 ft radius can be achieved not 70 ft as stated.

Jerry Tucker asked if a hammer head had been considered for a turn around? Michael Kraatz stated it had not.

Jerry Tucker reported that he had received many comments from citizens about a bike or hiking path in the Ranta Road / Green Mt. Turnpike area. Michael Kraatz stated that Okemo planned to tie into the proposed bike path but could not say where that would be.

Bob Cappiello asked how much retail space is proposed in this new development area? Michael Kraatz responded, 48,000 sq ft for designated skier services and 25,000 sq ft are undesig at this time.

*****MOTION MADE BY JERRY TUCKER: TO GIVE UP THE PORTION OF RANTA ROAD FROM THE INTERSECTION OF THE NEW ACCESS ROAD TO THE GREEN MT. TURNPIKE (SO CALLED) WITH THE CONDITIONS THAT OKEMO PROVIDED THE TOWN WITH A BIKE AND PEDESTRIAN EASEMENT TO CONNECT RANTA ROAD WITH THE GREEN MT. TURNPIKE. ALSO, THE CUL-DE-SAC AND GATE AS DISCUSSED AT PREVIOUS MEETING AND EMPHASIZED BY THE LETTER FROM RON PARRY BE CONSTRUCTED BY OKEMO MT. SUBJECT TO ACT 250 APPROVAL. SECONDED BY BOB CAPPIELLO. THE MOTION WAS PASSED UNANIMOUSLY IN FAVOR.**

Solid Waste Proposal:

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Jean Morrill asked how the budget would be affected next year. The answer was that the amount had already been budgeted and would not cause an increase in next years budget.




