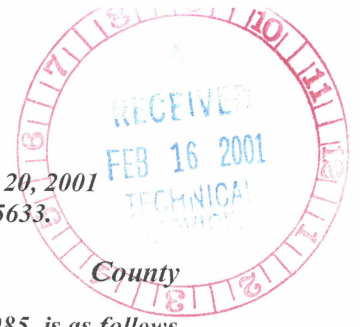

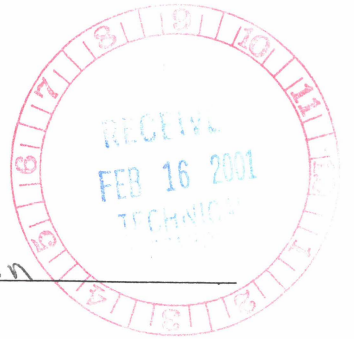

THE ABOVE IS A TRUE COPY OF THE DESCRIPTION OF CLASS 3 HIGHWAY COMPLETED AND OPENED FOR PUBLIC TRAVEL, RECORDED IN BOOK 63 ON PAGE 20-22 OF THE West Windsor Land RECORDS OF THE Town OF West Windsor ON THE 27th DAY OF October, 2000, AT 9:12 O'CLOCK, A.M.

Beginning on the southerly side of U.S. Route 44 at a point twenty five feet easterly of a point designated as "Point D" on the above mentioned surveys; thence proceeding in a southerly direction along the center line of the fifty foot right of way as depicted on said survey a distance of 450 feet, more or less, to the center line of the northerly edge of Yale Heights Covered Bridge, so-called, said point being equal distance between ground points marked as A-1 and B-1 on the above mentioned surveys; thence continuing S 24° 10' 51" W a distance of 118.35 feet to a point; thence continuing S 07° 37' 11" W a distance of 119.44 feet to a point; thence continuing S 21° 14' 16" W a distance of 83.36 feet to a point; thence continuing S 46° 14' 31" W a distance of 121.49 feet to a point; thence continuing S 43° 54' 34" W a distance of 80.31 feet to a point; thence continuing S 60° 38' 17" W a distance of 110.82 feet to a point; thence continuing S 60° 38' 18" W a distance of 75.00 feet to a point; thence continuing S 34° 22' 02" W a distance of 187.78 feet to a point; thence continuing S 25° 57' 05" W a distance of 372.69 feet to a point; thence continuing S 25° 57' 05" W a distance of 165 feet, more or less, to a point; thence continuing S 37° 02' 48" W a distance of 138.54 feet to a point; thence continuing southerly for a distance of 165 feet, more or less, to a point located twenty five feet from an iron pin set, designated as D-1 on Survey Drawing No. 85-493B; thence continuing S 26° 38' 17" E a distance of 100 feet, more or less, to the southerly edge of the cul de sac.

Being 2,287.78 feet, more or less, southerly of the beginning point at Vermont Route 44.
