We hereby certify that the preceding mileages to Montpelier have been prepared in accordance with Title 32, V.S.A., Section 1060. Mileage has been computed from the point designated as centrally located in each town, city or village. In those locations having one, the post office is the designated central point. Where there is no post office, a highway intersection near the most centrally located hamlet or settlement is the designated point. All mileage and centrally located points are shown on a map entitled Mileages to Montpelier Map, dated December 31, 1994, and filed in the Planning Division of the Vermont Agency of Transportation. All above mileage changes are due to VT 289 opening, which now sends traffic over VT 289 and VT 117, plus rounding.
