VERMONT GENERAL HIGHWAY MAP

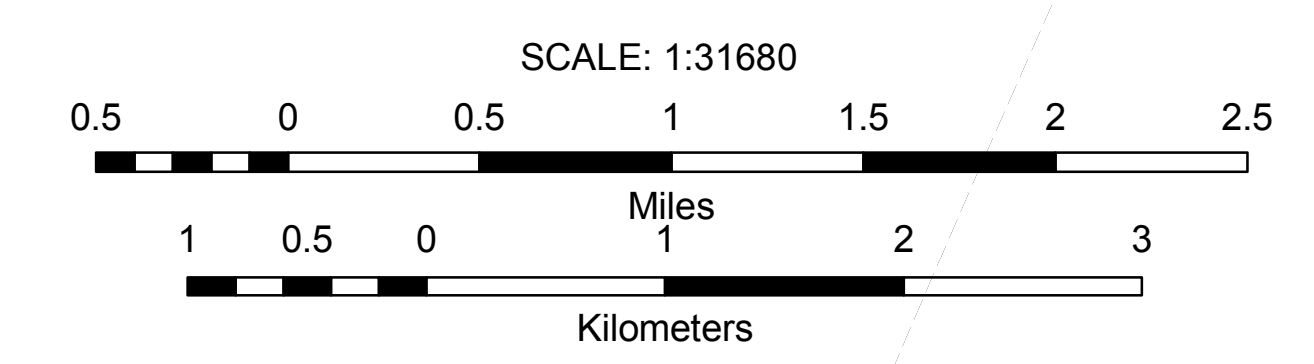
